

STUDY IN CHINA

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

ELIGIBILITY

- Students who are presently attending school in the U.S. should be in good academic standing with minimum GPA of 2.5
- International Programs may interview candidates to determine their qualifications
- International students are welcome to apply to JPLI programs, though some restrictions may apply. Contact program advisor for details.
- No Previous Chinese language skills are necessary.

HOW TO APPLY

Please follow the enclosed instruction carefully:

- All applicants must submit an online application
- All application materials should be submitted electronically.

The following material is required:

- Statement of Purpose: Please indicate your interest in the particular program or location and describe how the program will help reach your academic goals. Submission should be double – spaced, 1-2 typed pages,
- A copy of your official transcript indicating current level of education
- 6 passport photos (photos printed on regular paper not acceptable), mail or drop at the International program office.
- A copy of legible information page of your passport.
- Application form (you can download, and email or mail it in) - International Study in China

Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis until the program is full. **May 25**, is the application deadline, and **June 11st** is final deadline for current year. Applications will be accepted for the next year start in **November 1st** of each year.

There is a US \$55 non-refundable application fee. Once your application is reviewed and you receive an offer of admission, you must pay a non-refundable deposit of \$250.00 with your acceptance of the offer of admission. All admission decisions are made by the University which you're applying. JPLI will send additional information on the deposit with your offer of admission.

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Instructions for Completing Forms

School's Application Form

1. You should leave the following areas of the form blank:
Financial Guarantor Recommender'

2. If you do not yet have a passport, you should apply for one as soon as possible and write “applying” in the “Passport” section.
3. In the “Occupation/Status” section of the form you should enter “Student”.
4. You should write “JPLI Program” in the “Special request” section of the “Courses” area of the form.

Chinese Visa Application Form

You should enter the following in the numbered areas on the form that correspond to the numbers listed below:

11. You should enter “student”.
14. You should enter “Study”.
15. You should enter “Beijing” only, regardless of other travel plans you may have while you are in China.
16. You should enter “----- (the school you are attending), International students Division. (the city in China), China. Tel: _____”.
18. You should enter “Single”.
19. You should enter “60 days”.
