Dear students, faculty, and staff members

JPLI's top priority is the health, safety, and well-being of our students, faculty, and staff. We understand the concern and uncertainty you may be experiencing around the evolving situation, and we're committed to being responsive and flexible to our students, faculty and other employees' needs. In response to the spread of COVID-19, we have made the following decisions for all classes at JPLI until at least March 30. There is no plan to close the campus unless further notice.

- (1) Anyone who is not feeling well should stay at home. There are no makeup classes for any reason. However, an assignment and missing class's summary will be emailed to the student by the instructor.
- (2) Those who attend classes should try to keep a minimum distance of 2 meters or 6ft to each other and take elevators separately when possible.
- (3) Increasing the frequency of washing hands, cleaning and disinfecting. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- (4) Stay informed, pay attention to trusted health resources such as the [World Health Organization](#), [Centers for Disease Control](#), and your local health authorities.

There are hand sanitizers at the office and the classrooms.
