Deposit Requirement	You must submit a None – refundable application fee of \$250, payable to "JP Language Institute", when you file the application form with us. The deposit is required to reserve a place in one of our programs and other processes. If we are unable to accommodate you in one of our programs due to a lack of space, we will refund your deposit in full.		
Program Fees	Program Fee Includes: International airfare to/from our USA departure New York JFK and Shanghai or BeiJing China. All room accommodations in the university in China Meals on campus at attending school in China Program activity fees All domestic China air and surface (train and bus) transportation fees which hosted by JPLI or attending school. Program hosted educational attraction admission fees (historical sites, museums, temples, parks) Program leader, educator and tour guide fees.
